Construction update: Consistent rain has delayed paving, hoping to have paved prior to cold weather

Playground Activity Leaders (PALS) program has been introduced; PAL students were trained last week, they have been teaching games to students this week, they will initiate games at recess times. This program will integrate playing with younger and older students, increase physical fitness, reduce bullying and distract students from the playground equipment removal during construction.

5) Playground: School staff & council voted separately on favourite 2 playgrounds, both councils voted almost unanimously for #2 & #7

Allison will work with board & construction company - provide foot print of playgrounds, to establish potential locations sites. Currently the old beach volley ball court area is being thought of, tiger bush area has also been suggested

- 6) Budget: Voted to purchase additional insurance for all of our events, \$150 Approved by Krista, Kim Parent council currently gives \$10 per student to the class rooms discretionary fund, suggest we provide an additional \$5 per student for transportation coverage vote at next meeting
  - 7) Hot lunch: First month of operation shows roughly 1/2 the numbers of previous years order #'s. We are seeing a climb for the second month. Calendar has been set up for the entire year.

Reminders about new hot lunch program are going out with students, Allison is mentioning it in the newsletter.

We normally order extras for "angels", estimate about 8 angels this year, these meals are provided to council at cost. Discussed new way to do this as orders now have options, create email address for each angel, Allison will contact angels and take orders.
